
WHAT IS THE SUMMER CAMP AND WHO ORGANIZES IT?

Over the past 25 years the Reina Sofía School of Music
(https://www.escuelasuperiordemusicareinasofia.es/) has become one of the top
schools in Europe, with a broad and prestigious international recognition,
dedicated to classical music education of young talents from over
30 different countries.

The Reina Sofía School will make available for young students aged 12-17 the possibility to enhance and develop their musical talent, through its Summer program with the best music teachers, through a unique teaching method, and in an exceptional environment.

This year, from the 2nd to the 15th July, 2018, the Reina Sofía School will open its doors to the **Music & Culture Summer Camp**, an international summer camp where young people from all over the world will be able to take part in a 2-week course which gathers exclusive music training with instrumental technique, cultural activities and language classes in Spain (Madrid and Santander).

The School is chaired by H.M. Queen Sofía of Spain and the academic activities will take place in one-off facilities, at the Plaza de Oriente, next to the Royal Palace and the Almudena Cathedral, in a building with the most up-to-date technological facilities and classrooms with the best sound conditions.



WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE PROGRAM?

The program consists of a **2-week 'Musical, Cultural and Language Experience'** for **young people aged 12-17** and from different countries, with a full accommodation and meal plan (students who live in Madrid will be able to choose the Daily Camp Option).

The Summer Camp is aimed at three groups of youngster with different levels of music knowledge:

- Basic level: for those students with no musical education (or very basic), but eager to learn.
- Intermediate level: for those students with some experience, who already know they have the music in them.
- Advanced level: for the advanced students who want to enhance and broaden their musical knowledge, and for those
 aiming at more technical levels.

The program will be customized for each student, in accordance with the School's philosophy, so that each student can retrieve the maximum potential from the course.

The Summer Camp program includes:

• Musical and Cultural Program:

Theory: harmony and musical forms, history and live presentation of the instruments, history of the music and the arts

Instruments: practice of an instrument to be chosen by each student with a customized program and individual classes with instrument practice

Choir: all students will receive singing classes and practice in the choir

Concert for parents: the students will prepare a final performance for parents

Art: guided visits to the 3 main museums of Madrid (Prado, Thyssen, Reina Sofía)

connecting the classes of history of the music with the art works that will be seen in the
museums

Visit to instrument workshops and museums: visits to workshops that manufacture and repair instruments, visit to museums with instruments that have been used through the history and connection with the lessons of history of music

- Languages: Spanish classes for students coming from outside Spain and English classes for Spanish students.
 - Sports: swimming, water and team sports.
 - Trips and concerts:

Trip to Santander: Santander Encounter, with touristic visits and attendance to classical music concerts

Trip to the Royal Palace and other sight-seeing locations in Madrid Extra curricular activities



WHAT WILL THE STUDENTS GET OUT OF THE SUMMER CAMP?



>> MUSIC AND CULTURE

This course will allow the students, taking into account their experience level, to:

- · Learn and assimilate basic theoretical concepts of music.
- Rehearse with their instrument under the guidance of the School's Professors, who work training some of the top-level students worldwide; thus strengthening their musical abilities (or having a first approach to their instrument, if they have no experience at all).
- Take part, with the rest of the Summer Camp students, in the Camp's Choir.
- Learn about history of music and culture, visit museums, attend concerts and, at the end of the course, have a much richer perspective of music and its connection with culture.



>> LANGUAGES

The course will be given in English. There will be specific language lessons (Spanish for foreigners and English for Spanish students) and they will communicate with the instructors in different languages, which will allow the students an intensive immersion in foreign languages during those 15 days.




>> APTITUDES DEVELOPMENT

During the Summer Camp the students will be taught the **School values**, such as: perseverance, dedication, team work, high degrees of responsibility, and the promotion of the dialogue among nations through music and art.



>> SPORTS AND LEISURE TIME

Every day the students will play **sports and games** and will have **organized activities** during their leisure time together with their mates. All these, as well as the day trips, will ensure that their stay at the Summer Camp is a fun experience, where they will develop new exciting friendships.



WHERE WILL IT TAKE PLACE?

The Reina Sofía School of Music www.escuelasuperiordemusicareinasofia.es

is located at the Plaza de Oriente, a privileged location in the historical center of Madrid, nearby the Royal Palace and the Almudena Cathedral.

The School has the best facilities to study music, as well as a reference Concert Hall inside the building for rehearsals and concerts available for the students.

The building was opened in 2008 and has first class facilities and integrated security services.

The San Pablo College Residence www.cmsanpablo.es is one of the best residences for young students in Madrid and includes:

- · Individual and double rooms with air conditioning

- Classrooms

The price does not include trips from/to origin/destination countries for foreign students and transfers from/to airport.


There is also the option of 'Day Camp', without dinner and accommodation.
